GCU is conveniently located in the center of Phoenix, about 15 minutes from Sky Harbor International Airport and just a few miles from downtown.

From I-17

Exit on Camelback Road and proceed west. Continue on Camelback Road for one mile. The entrance to GCU will be on your right.

From Sky Harbor Airport

When exiting the airport:

- Follow signs for I-10 West / SR-51 North.
- Continue on I-10 West for five miles.
- Take exit 143A onto I-17 North towards Flagstaff.
- Continue on I-17 North for 3.4 miles.
- Take exit 203 - Camelback Road.
- Turn left onto Camelback Road.
- GCU will be on your right.
